1. Complete T1 Personal Income Tax Returns

including income slips (T4s, T4As, T5s, etc.)

for the past **three** years

2. Notice of Assessment & Reassessment

for the past **three** years

Employed

- 3. Two Recent Paystubs (or equivalent statement) showing year to date earnings, including overtime
- 4. Summary Page of benefits received from employment
- 5. Completed Tax Form T2200, if commissioned and deducting expenses.

Self Employed

- 3. Financial Statements
 (Assets & Debts, Income &
 Expenses) for every
 business, corporation or
 partnership you have an
 interest in, for the past
 three years
- 4. A list of any employees and corporations your business pays not considered "arm's length"
- 5. Any Shareholder or Parnership Agreements

Not Employed

- 3. If terminated from employment, your Record of Employment (ROE)
- 4. Stubs showing amount you are receiving for the following:

Employment Insurance,
Social Insurance, WSIB,
ODSP, disability payments,
Pension, Canada Pension
Plan, employment
severance

5. A resume setting out your education & work experience
